As requested by the court, I have performed a psychiatric evaluation which has included an extensive review of the court records of the trial in October, 2011, the custody evaluation by Dr. Edward Connor and Dr. Sarah Jones-Connor, the Judgment and Final Order on a Decree of Dissolution of marriage, a one on one interview (1 ½ hours) with Mr. Brewington at the prison in Putnamville on August 20, 2013, and several phone consultations with Dr. Chris [REDACTED].

When I saw Mr. Brewington in August 2013, I suggested that a brief period of graduated supervised visitation would be beneficial for both himself and especially his children, now that they haven't seen him for about 4 ½ years. If there were no reported situations that would jeopardize the safety of the children, then unsupervised visitation according to the Indiana State guide-lines would resume. This was agreeable to Mr. Brewington as his stated goal was "my job is to prove I'm not going to become a danger and get visitation of my girls"! He was also very amendable to ongoing psychotherapy after his release and had a scheduled appointment at the Affinity Center on September 9, 2013.

Unfortunately, I have not had an opportunity to meet with Mr. Brewington nor his daughters since his release from prison, which I would have preferred to do.
